1. READ GENERAL REGULATIONS.
2. Horses shall meet the general requirements. A negative Coggins test within 12 months for equine infectious anemia should be considered but it is not required. If you go on to any STATE SHOWS the Coggins test MUST accompany the health certificate.
3. Horses are shown at exhibitor's risk.
4. 4-H'ers participating in the show will be the only riders tolerated working with the horse the day of the show. 4-H'ers found in violation will be disqualified.
5. A properly executed identification certificate, identifying exhibitor and the horse they will exhibit or ride, must be presented to the superintendent upon arrival at the fairgrounds. This certificate must be completed before May 1, 2017.
6. 4-H Club members exhibiting should accompany their exhibits and care for them. Exhibitors must be on hand to exhibit their entries. Horses will be released following the judging.
7. The age of the horse is determined as of January 1, in the year in which it is born.
8. Stallions may not be exhibited in any class.
9. All exhibitors are encouraged to please refrain from allowing their horses to be ridden by any other person while at the fairgrounds.
10. No animal or 4-H member may show in the same class more than one time.
11. The use of protective headgear, in place of a hat, is the optional choice of exhibits in any and all Western classes, including judged & timed.
12. All horses should be properly groomed. The feet should be shod or trimmed, the mane and tail should be clean and combed, the face and ears may or may not be shaved.
13. A 4-H'er may have two animals per halter class. If so, another 4-H'er must exhibit the second animal. Halter classes are numbers 695 - 697.
14. A 4-H'er may have only one entry per other classes. Classes 700 - 739.
15. No classes are qualifying classes for the state fair.

1. The 4-H Dog Show will be held at the Stafford County Fairgrounds, Sunday, July 09, 2017 starting at 5:00 p.m.

- 2. READ GENERAL REGULATIONS.
- 3. PRE-ENTRY FORMS ARE DUE IN THE EXTENSION OFFICE BY FRIDAY, JUNE 16, 2017
- 4. Dogs at the show must be kept on leash at all times except when competing in 'off leash' competition.
- 5. All dogs must be six months of age or older at the date of show to enter obedience.
- 6. 4-H Dog Show Immunization Record (only MG-34 Revised, October 2014 accepted), must be completed for each dog entered in the 4-H Dog Show. The fully completed form just be presented to the superintendent on the day of the show to be eligible to compete.
- 7. All entries are required to have trained their dog with assistance from the leader and must be currently enrolled in the Dog Project. Read County Dog Project requirements for details.
- 8. Dogs will be worked individually. They will be judged by how well the dog is groomed and by handlers exhibition of dog.
- 9. Any abuse of dogs on grounds, or in the ring, will result in disqualification.
- 10. No dog in season will be allowed to show.
- 11. Any dog fouling the ring will receive a white ribbon. Owners should collect all waste in plastic bags and put in trash.
- 12. Baiting dogs is not allowed.
- 13. The County Dog Show will follow rules as listed in the published Kansas 4-H Dog rule books: Kansas 4-H Dog Show Rule Book (S-46 (Revised), April 2012; Kansas 4-H Agility Dog Show Rule Book, S-124 (Revised), March 2012; Kansas 4-H Rally Obedience Rule Book, 4H965 (Revised), March 2012. Other guidelines are: Kansas 4-H

Dog Show Judge's Guidelines Showmanship/Obedience, S82 (Revised), January 2013 and March 2012; and Kansas 4-H Rally Obedience Dog Show Judge's Guide, 4H1023 March 2013.

OBEDIENCE

CLASS

750 - Pre-Novice A - A first year member with a first year dog. Total Possible Points - 160

Heel and Figure 8 on leash, Stand for examination on leash, Recall on leash, Long sit – 1 minute, Long down – 3 minutes

751 - Pre-Novice B - For a first year dog with an experienced handler or a dog and handler who did not qualify in Pre-Novice last year. Total Possible Points - 160

Heel and Figure 8 on leash, Stand for examination on leash, Recall on leash, Long sit – 1 minute, Long down – 3 minutes.

752 - Novice - For all 4-H'ers and dogs who have qualified in Sub-Novice under two different certified judges the previous year.

Heel and figure 8 on leash, Stand for examination off leash, Heel off leash, Recall off leash, Long sit - 1 minute off leash, Long down - 3 minutes off leash.

753 - Graduate Novice - For all 4-H'ers and dogs who have qualified in Novice under two different certified judges the previous year.

Heel on leash, Stand for examination off leash, Heel and figure 8 off leash, Drop on recall; Long sit - member out of sight 3 minutes, Long down – member out of sight 5 minutes.

754 - Open A - For all 4-H'ers and dogs who have qualified in Graduate Novice under two different certified judges the previous year. All exercises off leash. recall, Retrieve on flat, Broad jump, Long sit - member out of sight 3 minutes, Long down - member out of sight 5 minutes

755 - Open B --- For all 4-H'ers and dogs who have qualified In Open A under two different certified judges the previous year. All exercises off leash.

Heel and figure 8, Drop on recall, Retrieve on flat, Retrieve over high jump, Broad jump, Long sit - member out of sight 3 minutes, Long down - member out of sight 5 minutes.

SHOWMANSHIP

Will be judged on fitting of dog; clean and well brushed tone and condition of coat, healthy appearance, teeth, toenails, and eyes. Handler will be judged on alertness, grace, and ease, coordination with dog and reaction of dog to handler with straight and even gait and movement of dog.

760 - Junior Showmanship (4-H'ers who are 9 - 11 years)
