1. Any lamb shown in the market class cannot be shown in the breeding classes and vice versa.

2. All ram lambs must be born after January 1, 2017. All exhibitors in this class must be enrolled in the sheep project.
3. All market lambs must be born after January 1, 2017.
4. All market lambs must be identified with a State approved 4-H ear tag to be eligible to show and sale.
5. All Sheep including wethers must be identified with an official USDA premise ID tag.
6. All market lambs will be shown by breed and classes within breed will be determined by superintendents if necessary.

**NOTE:** A Stafford County Bred class is being offered and a lamb shown in this class MUST be a lamb bred and owned by OR purchased from a Stafford County Sheep producer, or a lamb bred and owned by or purchased from a 4-H'er enrolled in the Stafford County Sheep Project. All lambs shown in this class will be shown together and sub classes determined by weight, not breed.

- 656 -- White face/Speckled
- 657 -- Black face
- 658 -- Stafford County Bred

## 4-H BREEDING SHEEP

In the Breeding sheep, each breed will use the same class numbers but add the letter:

H - Hampshire; S - Suffolk; C - Crossbreed; D - Dorset; and O - All Other Breeds

Example: Class 715 D - Dorset Ewe Lamb

### CLASS

- 665 - Ewe Lamb - born after January 1, current year
- 666 - Fall Born Ewe Lamb - born between September 1 - December 31, previous year
- 667 - Yearling Ewe - born before September 1, previous year
- 668 - 2 year old and older Ewe - born 3 years previous
- 669 - Ram Lamb - born after January 1, current year

## 4-H SHEEP SHOWMANSHIP

### CLASS

- 670 -- Showmanship 12 and under
- 671 -- Showmanship 13 and over

**675 -- Prospect 4-H'er Lamb Show --** Exhibitors must be 6 years of age or younger and either own or borrow a lamb for exhibition purposes and lead the lamb on a halter.
