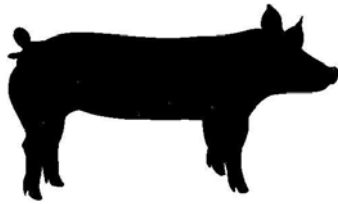

## 4-H MARKET BARROWS AND GILTS

1. All animals in this division shall have been born on or after January 1, 2017.
2. The classification for judging will be based upon weight. All barrows and gilts will be weighed as they are checked in opening day of Fair. All barrows and gilts UNDER 220 pounds will be shown in one class and swine weighing OVER 290 pounds will be shown in one overweight class. They will NOT BE eligible for the Championship Drive AND ARE NOT to be sold at the 4-H Livestock Sale at the conclusion of the Fair.
3. All market swine must be identified with a State approved 4-H ear tag to be eligible to show and sale.
4. All market barrows regardless of breed will show together. Champion barrow will compete with Champion gilt for determining Grand Champion Market Hog.
5. All market gilts regardless of breed will show together. Champion gilt will compete with champion barrows for determining Grand Champion Market Hog.
6. Swine originating in Kansas must meet the general requirements. Kansas has obtained Stage V status in the National Pseudo rabies Program and the state is classified free of swine brucellosis. A negative Pseudo rabies and brucellosis test are NOT required for Kansas origin swine.
7. The Stafford County Fair is a Ractopamine Hydrochloride (PAYLEAN) free show. Any pigs found to have been fed Ractopamine Hydrochloride will be automatically disqualified and will forfeit any awards and/or premium money.

## 4-H BREEDING SWINE

1. Gilts must have been farrowed on or after January 1, 2017. And exhibitor must be enrolled in the swine project.
2. Sows shown in this division must have been carried in breeding phase of the swine project.
3. Breeding animals exhibited by 4-H'ers will be returned home at EXHIBITORS OWN RISK and the Stafford County Fair and Fair Officials will not be held responsible for the death, injury or spread of disease.
4. Those 4-H'ers enrolled in swine projects who DO NOT wish to exhibit breeding animals at the County Fair will be able to display in the Educational Exhibit Section - Class 1035 - 1038 category.

In the Breeding Swine Class, each breed will use the same class numbers but add the letter Y - Yorkshire; D - Duroc; H - Hampshire; C - Crossbred; SP - Spot; and P - Poland.

## CARCASS EVALUATION AND SHOW RULES

1. One entry per exhibitor.
2. Entries must meet fair weight requirements of 220-290lbs. Underweight and overweight pigs are not eligible for the Carcass show.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for the processing charges of their animals. These animals will not be sold at Floor.
4. Exhibitors must make processing arrangements with Ellinwood Packing by July 7, 2017, Ph. 620-564-3156.
5. Each member will be responsible for their animal's care following the fair and its delivery to the processing plant (Ellinwood Packing) before 8:00 am on July 20st.
6. Animal carcasses will be judged July 21, 2017 with viewing by participant July 21, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. at the Ellinwood Packing Facility.
7. Awards will be given for the first three places 1st - \$75, 2nd - \$50 and 3rd - \$25. Other entries will receive ribbons and ribbon premium money.
