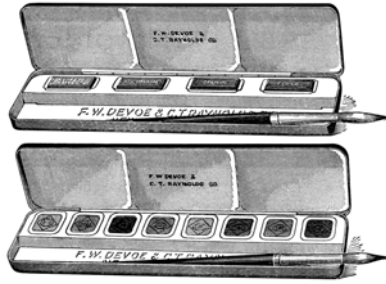


OPEN CLASS ARTS AND CRAFTS

1. Check in will be from 8:00-10:00 am on Wednesday, July 12, 2017. Judging will begin at 11:00 am.
2. Each entry will use the same class number, each age group of exhibitors will have a letter: **A - Preschool; B - Grade School; C - High School and D - Adults.** (Example – 335A - Preschool Stenciling)
3. Competition open to residents of Stafford and adjoining counties.
4. Each exhibitor is limited to 2 entries per class.
5. All work must be the work of the exhibitor completed in the last year.
6. All drawings and paintings must be securely mounted and have a wire or tab for hanging (high school, and adults only)
7. All exhibits must be entered between 8 am - 10 am Wednesday, July 12 and cannot be removed before 7:30 pm Saturday, July 15.
8. All premiums will be \$3. \$2. \$1 in each class.
9. An Overall Grand Champion & Reserve Champion will be selected from all classes combined.

HOBBIES AND COLLECTIONS

371. Hobbies/Collections – Exhibit should be displayed in a container appropriate to the hobby/collection. Cardboard boxes with commercial writing visible will not be allowed. Exhibit **MUST** include a narrative (printed on 8 1/2 x 11 paper, no less than 12 point font or handwritten on large note-card) explaining what the collection is and why and how the collection was started.
